

## B.S. DEGREE IN HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GLOBAL CLUB MANAGEMENT MAJOR

2016 - 2017

**Admission Requirements:**

The Global Club Management major is a limited access program. To be admitted to the Global Club Management major, students must (1) have completed at least 52 semester hours, (2) have completed ACG 2021, ACG 2071, CGS 2100 or CGS 2518, ECO 2013, ECO 2023, MAC 2233, and STA 2023 with a grade of “C-” or better in each course, and (3) have an overall GPA of at least 2.50 on all prior college level work.

The overall GPA required for the 2016-2017 academic year (Fall 2016, Spring 2017, and Summer 2017) is 2.50.

The overall GPA required is subject to change each academic year.

**Additional Information:**

1. Global Club Management majors are required to complete 6 months of approved internship. Internships must be approved by the Internship Director for Global Club Management.
2. Global Club Management Majors are required to complete a Global Component to include one of the following: International Internship, Study Abroad Experience with FSU International Programs, or a Domestic Internship with a Multinational Corporation.
3. Global Club Management Majors are required to meet a Foreign Language Component through proof of proficiency in a second language or successful completion of one semester of a second language.
4. Attendance and/or participation in a minimum of 6 industry events is required. These may include but are not limited to: Club Management Association of America (CMAA) National Student Conference, CMAA World Conference, PGA Merchandise Show, CMAA FSU Student Chapter Club Tour Events, and FSU Dedman School Leadership Summit.
5. **In addition to the requirements outlined above, each student must complete all University-wide requirements for graduation.** These requirements include liberal studies requirements, the multicultural requirement, the summer school requirement, the FSU residency requirement, and total hours requirements.
6. Students must not enroll in any course at another institution without first receiving approval from the Dedman School. Once enrolled at FSU, students should plan to take their Hospitality courses at FSU. Any exception to this policy must be approved in advance by the Dedman School. Transfer of upper-level Global Club Management courses completed prior to enrolling at FSU must be from other 4-year, accredited institutions. These courses must be approved for course substitution by the Dedman School upon entering FSU.
