## B.S. DEGREE IN HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT MAJOR

**2015 - 2016**

**Admission Requirements:**

The Hospitality Management major is a limited access program. To be admitted to the Hospitality Management major, students must (1) have completed at least 52 semester hours, (2) have completed ACG 2021, ACG 2071, CGS 2100 or CGS 2518, ECO 2013, ECO 2023, MAC 2233, and STA 2023 with a grade of “C-” or better in each course, and (3) have an overall GPA of at least 2.50 on all prior college level work.

The overall GPA required for the 2015-2016 academic year (Fall 2015, Spring 2016, and Summer 2016) is 2.50. The overall GPA required is subject to change each academic year.

**Additional Information:**

- Hospitality Management majors must complete 1,000 hours of work experience in the hospitality industry at the post-secondary level. Students must report hours to the Internship Director to receive credit for their work hours.
- Students are required to complete a Management Internship(s) for academic credit (HFT 3941) through the Dedman School as part of their work experience (3 credit hours must be earned).** The hours worked during the Management Internship(s) will count toward the required 1,000 hours of work experience. For further information about Internships, please contact the Dedman School, Internship Director, 850-644-8245.
- In addition to the requirements outlined above, each student must complete all University-wide requirements for graduation.** These requirements include liberal studies requirements, the multicultural requirement, the Gordon Rule writing requirement, the summer school requirement, the FSU residency requirement, and total hours requirements.
- Students needing elective hours to satisfy the University 120 total hours requirement are encouraged to take additional courses from the list of hospitality electives that are taught in the Dedman School beyond the semester hours required.
- Typically, Hospitality Management courses are not offered in the Summer terms at the Main Campus. The Dedman School offers a Summer Study Program in Switzerland through FSU International Programs. In addition, the Dedman School offers a Summer Resort Management Program in Destin, FL.
- Students must not enroll in any course at another institution without first receiving approval from the Dedman School. Once enrolled at FSU, students should plan to take their Hospitality courses at FSU. Any exception to this policy must be approved in advance by the Dedman School. Transfer of upper-level Hospitality courses completed prior to enrolling at FSU must be from other 4-year, accredited institutions. These courses must be approved for course substitution by the Dedman School upon entering FSU.
